Section 3: Supplemental (Non-Vacancy Specific) Recruitment Activities Undertaken by

I. Internship Program to Provide Work Experience in the Broadcasting Industry.

February 2005 to January 2006 – The stations conduct an ongoing internship program, which seeks to attract students from local schools and colleges to gain exposure to career opportunities in broadcasting and experience in broadcast radio programming and operations. Program directors Mike Carson and Rick Stevens are responsible for this internship, which is publicized to local colleges and listed on the stations' web sites. Participation varies from semester to semester, and during the applicable period, the stations did not have a student participate in the ongoing program.

II. Participation In Activities And Events Or Programs Sponsored By Educational Institutions Relating To Career Opportunities In Broadcasting.

January 2006 – Job shadowing at Sales Seminar – As the result of a posting at Louisiana College, Allison Valentine, a student at the college, participated in a job shadowing program at the stations. Allison worked with President and General Manager, Kim Jones, and gained exposure to radio marketing and sales during her job shadow at the station. She was subsequently hired for a full time sales account executive position at the stations.
